Muralist Joshua Winer's residency at Pike Posted 10/07/2011 12:31PM



Joshua Winer, award-winning muralist, mosaic artist, and educator, spent several weeks working with Pike students to create a three-part mosaic for a large wall in the Pike dining room. The theme of the project is "Creativity and Imagination," and Winer worked throughout last spring with Lower and Middle School students on the design phase. Art teachers Vanessa Taylor and Chris Vivier then finalized the design with Winer, based on the students' ideas and drawings. After making the necessary preparations during the summer, Winer guided Pike students, faculty, staff, and parents through the mosaic construction during art classes this fall.



Winer's background includes a Degree in Fresco Painting from the Skowhegan School of Painting and Sculpture, a Bachelor's Degree in Fine Arts from Yale University, and a Master's Degree in Architecture from Harvard University.

Winer has created more than 100 murals and works of public art in a variety of media, including paint, mosaic, ceramic, brick, metal, and wood.
